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VOLUNTEERS COMMITMENT AGREEMENT

As a Christian campsite, we seek to promote Christian values. Below are two lists that outline what we are asking you to commit to while serving with us as a volunteer to ensure that a high standard is followed at all our CYC Camps.

Please ensure you have read over these lists and looked at any information you need to know before serving at a CYC Camp. On the last page of this form, there are some links to our website where you can find out more information about some of the things mentioned in the below lists.

Once you've read the 'Volunteers Commitment Agreement', sign the last section and send a copy to the CYC Camps Coordinator at CYCCoordinator@cycsa.org.au.

I understand that:

- For volunteers, the camp starts at the time of the training meeting and will end after the debriefing meeting of the camp.
- I'm required to stay on camp for the entire duration of the camp and outside activities or events should not interfere with my role without prior approval from the CYC Camps Coordinator.
- My attitude and behaviour as a camper, and in my personal life, can contribute to whether I am accepted to a volunteer role.
- There are some forms that the campsite requires me to do during and after camp and I'll get these done on time.
- I need to get all certificates and forms filled in from the '[Required Forms](#)' page on our website and returned to the CYC Camps Coordinator to be confirmed for a CYC Camp.

I understand that to participate in any volunteer role at a CYC Camp, I will be committing myself to:

- Understanding and abiding by the '[Expectations of a CYC Volunteers](#)' from the CYC website's 'Volunteer Expectations' page.
- Ensuring that my motivation for coming to camp is to share the Gospel of Christ.
- Having a belief in God as my Savior and a good understanding of who Christ is, the purpose of the Bible and a commitment to sharing my own personal Christian faith.
- Participate in all required training for this camp or organise another time to do this one-on-one.
- Taking the time to pray before, during, and after camp.
- The authority of the Camp Director and or the CYC Staff.
- Supervising and ensuring the safety of all campers, encouraging participation, and helping to create a fun, friendly and safe environment.
- Live out the CYC's Vision, Mission, and Values on the camp outlined on the '[Mission](#)' page on the CYC website.
- Living a life that demonstrates my faith in Christ and striving to become more Godly in all I do, whether at or outside of camp.
- Follow all the statements within the CYC El Shaddai '[Code of Conduct](#)' and the '[Children and Young People Safety Policy](#)' from the '[Become a Leader](#)' page on the CYC website.
- Understanding and abiding by all the policies and procedures that have been sent to me ahead of camp; Language, Electronic Devices, Clothing, Relationships, etc.
